## Expanding Impact Through National Partnerships

DCA National Partnerships with sports governing bodies continue to build momentum around the PCA Movement. The latest developments include

- Launching Little League Double-Goal Coach and Little League Second-Goal Parent Online Quick Courses. The free 20 -minute courses featuring video of PCA National Advisory Board Member and Former Major League Baseball Player and Manager Dusty Baker, introduce coaches and parents to PCA principles (i.e., Filling Emotional Tanks) and tools (i.e., Mistake Ritual to help youth athletes recover from their mistakes). Heavy promotion from Little League drove more than 1,500 users through the courses within a month of their launch in April 2014.
- Further integrating PCA Training into US Lacrosse. The organization - PCA's first National Partner - augmented its Coaching Education

Program to incorporate Double-Goal Coach training into US Lacrosse's day-long coaching courses. The new approach has several US Lacrosse coaching educators now trained to deliver PCA content in tandem with on-field strategic and tactical in struction, which helps coaches internalize DoubleGoal Coach techniques. This program will result in more than 6,000 USL coaches trained during the coming year.

- Added support for Amateur Athletic Union. The three-year-old program funded by a grant from the S. D. Bechtel, Jr. Foundation - which has provided free online courses to tens of thousands of AAU coaches - welcomed TeamSnap as the exclusive corporate partner for this course. TeamSnap, provider of online team-management tools for youth sports, will help PCA reach new AAU coaches and engage repeat users in more advanced PCA content.
